

Example Endorsement format for general use

On Oct. 28, 2015, the Issaquah District School Board approved the \$533,500,000 school bond ballot resolution to be put before the voters on April 26, 2016.

ISSAQUAH SCHOOL DISTRICT GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS -

\$533,500,000 The Board of Directors approved Resolution No. 1063 concerning this proposition for bonds. This proposition authorizes the District to acquire property; construct a new high school, middle school and two elementary schools; rebuild Pine Lake Middle; expand/modernize Cougar Ridge, Discovery, Endeavor, Maple Hills, and Sunset elementary schools and Beaver Lake Middle; make other capital improvements including technology; issue \$533,500,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum term of 20 years; and levy excess property taxes annually to repay the bonds, as described in Resolution No. 1063.

“In order for our *organization* to advocate for a yes vote on this bond, we’ll need to have an endorsement vote.”
